## GETTING THERE:

### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

Train to Windermere - The warden has created a map to guide you on the beautiful, 20 minute walk, through the woods, from Windermere train station. (See page 3)

### BY ROAD: (SEE MAP ON PAGE 2)

#### FROM KENDAL:

- Leave Kendal on A591 Ambleside Windermere road
- Pass through Ings and the filling station on left
- On reaching Windermere (and the train station) do not turn left into town but continue towards Ambleside, Grasmere on A591
- Pass St Mary's Church on LHS
- On reaching mini roundabout, turn RIGHT on to A592 to Ullswater and Patterdale, Kirkstone Pass
- Follow road for 200 metres. At the end of a long beech hedge on RHS there are some iron railings and a pair of stone pillars. You'll see a silver NT Omega sign, turn RIGHT over the cattle grid onto track
- Follow track up the field and bear to the right across another a cattle grid


#### FROM KESWICK:

- Pass south through Ambleside on A591
- You will pass various large hotels on either side of road for few miles. After White Cross Bay caravan park on RHS, there is a sharp left hand bend and you will pass a petrol station on RHS. This is Troutbeck Bridge. Continue up the hill past the Sun Inn to a mini roundabout
- TURN LEFT at the mini roundabout signed A592 Ullswater, Patterdale, Kirkstone Pass
- Follow road for 200 metres. At the end of a long beech hedge on RHS there are some iron railings and a pair of stone pillars. You'll see a silver NT Omega sign, turn RIGHT over the cattle grid onto track
- Follow track up the field and bear to the right across another a cattle grid

### PARKING:

You are asked to park only on the car park, and not on the verges or driveway. As we shall be the only people using the building, it will be possible to block each other in, if the car park becomes full.

There's space for one or two cars just beyond the car park, which are a little bit nearer to the buildings we shall be using. If you have limited mobility and need one of these spaces, let us know in advance so we can reserve one for you. Go through the opening at the left at the end of the car park then turn immediately right in front of the house. One space is immediately on the right and there's space for one or two more cars at the side of the house on the left.
